### **Checklist to Prepare for Officer JumpStart**

- Determine student cost to attend with your officers
- Discuss dress code requirements with officers
- Obtain chapter's charter information to log into registration system
- Log in to register for event by deadline
- Print copy of chapter's registration and triple check for accuracy before deadline
- Submit registration
- Derogram of Work from previous school year, questions for chapter success and a writing utensil
