BIG PICTURE OVERVIEW

1. Online tests only:

- a. Behavioral Health, Cultural Diversity & Health Disparity, Dental Terminology, Epidemiology, Forensic Science, Foundations of Medical Terminology, Health Career Exploration, Healthcare Issues Exam, Health Informatics, Human Growth & Development, Math for Health Careers, Medical Law and Ethics, Medical Math, Medical Reading, Medical Terminology, Nutrition, Pathophysiology, Pharmacology = 18

2. Submission ONLY via link:

- a. Barbara James Award, Clinical Specialty, Community Awareness, Exploring Medical Innovation, Extemporaneous Health Poster- Middle School Only, Health Career Display[^] - MS, Health Career Photography, Health Careers Preparation, Health Education, Healthy Lifestyle, HOSA Happenings, Medical Innovation, MRC Partnership, National Service Project, Outstanding State Leader, Prepared Speaking, Public Health, Public Service Announcement, Research Poster Presentation, Researched Persuasive Writing and Speaking, Speaking Skills = 21

3. Link submission and live appointment:

- a. Interviewing Skills, Job Seeking Skills, Life Support Skills, Personal Care =4

4. Online test and live appointment:

- a. Biomedical Laboratory Science, CERT, Clinical Nursing, CPR/First Aid, Dental Science, Emergency Medical Technician, Home Health Aide, Life Threatening Situations, Medical Assisting, Nursing Assisting, Pharmacy Science, Physical Therapy, Sports Medicine, Veterinary Science
- b. Biomedical Debate, HOSA Bowl, Medical Spelling
- c. Creative Problem Solving, Dynamic Decisions =20

5. Live appointment ONLY:

- a. Extemporaneous Writing =1

TESTING

- All testing will be conducted online. The same rules/ guidelines that were used for State Qualification Testing will be used. (Can be found [HERE](#))
- For team testing events, (Forensic Science, HOSA Bowl, etc.) team members must log in to test within one hour of each other. Teams will need to coordinate together to find the best time they want to test within the allowed 24 hour window.
- Virtual proctoring is permitted for those school systems who do not allow In-Person testing OR for those students who are at-home learners.
- When filling out the [Proctor Form](#) please verify which format you will be proctoring.
- If proctoring students in person and virtually- this should be done at the same time to protect the integrity of the test.

SKILL EVENTS

- Skill events with round 2 components will be given a live appointment. During these live appointments, the student will be given a scenario and they will **verbalize** the skill/ scenario response. All skills used will be from the posted guidelines. No demonstrations/ equipment will be required.

MEDICAL SPELLING

- Round 1 online test will take place first. The test time has been decreased from 60 minutes to 30 minutes. Then top scoring competitors will be asked to join a live Zoom meeting with the judges. Competitors will individually be given spelling terms and will go down a predetermined list of words. Competitors who get the furthest on the word lists will be declared 1-10th place winners.

EXTEMPORANEOUS HEALTH POSTER

- The secret topic will be posted **Friday, Feb 12th**. Competitors will submit their finished poster on **February 14th**.

EXTEMPORANEOUS WRITING

- This event will be done in the online testing platform.. Competitors will login to the platform, see the secret topic, and type their essay in response to the secret topic. Some of the formatting requirements will be removed since the typing will be done within the online platform. Please see chart for dates.

JOB SEEKING SKILLS

INTERVIEWING SKILLS

- No application will be used. The cover letter and resume will be judged through the link as a round 1 and selected competitors will advance to round 2. For round 2, competitors will meet virtually with judges via Zoom and answer judge interview questions live at a set time. Final results will be determined by live interview score.

PREPARED SPEAKING

SPEAKING SKILLS

RESEARCHED PERSUASIVE WRITING & SPEAKING

- Competitors will upload a video recording of themselves giving their prepared speech.
- The requirement to upload the Researched Persuasive Writing & Speaking paper to the link remains the same, as does the requirement for the eligibility form for Speaking Skills.
- Final score for RPS will still be paper plus presentation.

BIOMEDICAL DEBATE-

- All teams will take the round 1 test. A select number of teams for round 2 will participate in a modified debate / presentation with judges via a live platform like Zoom. More information on the live debate presentation will be coming soon. Final results will be test score plus debate score.

FORENSIC SCIENCE

- The round 1 test will be done on the online testing system. The online test will ALSO contain an autopsy / police report information for the case study. Teams will be asked to read the case study information and type their responses. Team members will take the test and answer case study questions individually, but scores will be averaged between both team members for final placement.

CREATIVE PROBLEM SOLVING

DYNAMIC DECISIONS

- All teams will take the round 1 test scheduled sometime between Feb 1st -5th.
- Round 1 Test- then the secret topic will be posted Friday, Feb 12th. Competitor videos will be due Feb 14th
- Scores on the video presentations will be added to the test scores for final placement.

HOSA BOWL

- All teams will still take the round 1 test. A select number of teams for round 2 will either participate in a live event with judges on Zoom or participate by answering questions online in a quizbowl game format.

HEALTH CAREER PREPARATION

- The statement of interest will be uploaded to a posted Wufoo link for review by judges. Competitors will also be asked to record a video of themselves answering verbally the same questions in the statement of interest. The video will be uploaded at the same posted link by **February 14th**. Final score will be the statement of interest plus video presentation.

PUBLIC HEALTH

- Teams and competitors will record a video of their presentation normally given to the judges
 - Teams will upload these presentations to the submission link.
- Teams DO NOT need to be physically with each other for the presentations. Options will be shared to allow teams to record their presentations virtually through platforms such as Zoom, Go To Meeting, etc. See the [Video Recorded Presentation Guidelines](#).
- Public Health will upload the round 2 video presentation only. Final score will be based only on the round 2 video presentation.
